Biography



On December 16, 1968, I was born into a devout Catholic family in Ahmednagar, Maharashtra. My parents, the Late Joseph Raj and RoseMary Raj, instilled in us a strong foundation of faith and values. As the youngest of six siblings—one sister and four brothers—I was blessed to grow up in a home deeply rooted in Catholic traditions.

In 1971, due to my father's service in the defense sector, our family relocated to Itarsi. It was here that my spiritual journey began to take shape. As a child, I was profoundly influenced by Fr. Amirtharaj OP from Pachmarhi, who frequently visited our parish in Itarsi for spiritual activities. His dedication and devotion ignited a deep desire within me to follow in his footsteps and dedicate my life to God's service.

This calling led me to join the Dominican Order in 1990. My initial postulancy took place in Mangalore, followed by a year-long novitiate in Goa from 1991 to 1992. Thereafter, I pursued my major seminary studies at St. Charles in Nagpur from 1992 to 1995, completing my philosophy along with a Bachelor of Arts degree. My regency period in 1995-1996 was spent in the Diocese of Varanasi, enriching my understanding of pastoral service. I then returned to Nagpur to undertake four years of theological studies from 1996 to 2000.

The pinnacle of my spiritual journey was on April 23, 2000, when I was ordained as a priest in Itarsi. It was the most joyful day of my life—a moment filled with immense gratitude and devotion. My heart overflows with appreciation for my family, my formators, and all those who have supported and guided me throughout my journey to the priesthood. Their unwavering faith and encouragement have been instrumental in shaping my mission and commitment to serving the Church and the community.

Short History of Our Lady of Forsaken Church, Ghansoli, Navi Mumbai.

In the mid-1980s, the absence of a church in Navi Mumbai compelled residents to travel to Thane or neighboring cities for religious services. Recognizing this need, a few Catholic families residing in Ghansoli took the initiative to establish a church in their locality. On December 3rd, 1984, a significant step was taken as St. John the Baptist Church in Thane acquired a plot for this purpose. The newly acquired land was christened "OUR LADY OF FORSAKEN CHURCH" in Ghansoli.

The visionary founding priest, Late Reverend Fr. Peter J. Bombacha, bestowed his blessings upon the land and initiated the construction of the church with the invaluable assistance of local residents. This marked the commencement of a journey that would shape the spiritual landscape of the community.

The dedication and contributions of the locals played a pivotal role in the growth of the church, fostering a sense of faith, unity, togetherness, and overall well-being within the community. As construction progressed, the church emerged not just as a physical structure but as a symbol of the collective spirit and determination of the people of Ghansoli to establish a place of worship in their midst.

Until 2006, the spiritual ministry of Our Lady of Forsaken Church was entrusted to the priests of the Archdiocese of Bombay. Thereafter, the Dominic's Fathers undertook the sacred duty of overseeing the spiritual well-being of the congregation.
